**Circular NO. 6**

To the Board of Directors, Advisory Council, Committee Members, National Association Presidents, State Directors, Regional Secretaries, Table Directors and all Members of the Alliance of Pan American Round Tables.

My very dear Pan American Friends:

I am again informing you of our Pan American activities and sending you my best wishes so that the year 2010 will bring you happiness, emotional harmony, well-being and prosperity. May our Pan American work be the path that will bring us nearer to achieving peace in our countries.

From the 6<sup>th</sup> to the 8<sup>th</sup> of November, 2009, I traveled to the city of Mérida, Yucatán, México, to meet with the Organizing Committee of the XXXII Alliance Convention and visit several haciendas to decide where the Regional Dinner will be held. It was very satisfying to verify that Mrs. Lucy Pérez Aranda de Omaña, the Chairman of the Organizing Committee and the members of said Committee are working with much enthusiasm and efficiency, with the valuable assistance of Mrs. Enriqueta Esparza de González, Director of the Montejo de Mérida Host Table and all its members. They are awaiting us with open arms.

It is recommended that you reserve your room in the site Hotel Fiesta Americana Mérida as soon as possible, since there are other events scheduled for that same date and the rooms may be exhausted. The Cost of the Registration Fee is \$270.00 USD for members and guests and must be paid before September 13, 2010. Late registrations will not be accepted.

From January 21<sup>st</sup> to the 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2010, I attended the II Board Meeting of the National Association of Pan American Round Tables of the Republic of México, which was held in Manzanillo, Colima. I am grateful for the courtesies extended to me by Mrs. María Eva Muñoz de Manzarraga, National Association President, by Mrs. Isabel Bernardo de Ferreras, Chairman of the Organizing Committee, Margarita de la Mora Wong, Manzanillo Table Director and all the members.

Also in Manzanillo, a Called Meeting was held on January 22, 2010, with Alliance Officers from Zones IIIA, IIIB and IIIC and with the valuable counsel of Advisors Delia Pérez de Plata and Fabiola García de Steffanoni. Also attending were Alliance Parliamentarian and Advisor Norma Ríos de Flores, Elsie Pérez, Alliance Zone 1

The resolutions taken were the following:

1. Issuance of 500 Pan American Bulletins to be delivered one to each Alliance Officer and two to each Table Director or Delegate. The Zone Directors will deliver the Bulletins to the Officers and Tables not present.
2. Approval for the Format for Preparation of the Pan American Curriculum which will be attached to Circular No. 1 of the Nominations Committee. The candidates nominated for an Alliance Board position must use said format.
3. Approval of the Placement Diagram for Alliance Officers and Delegates to be used by the XXXII Organizing Committee and the Alliance Protocol Committee to assign seating at the meetings according to this diagram.
4. Appointment of Miss Yolanda Aquino Díaz, as Vice-chairman and two members per Zone to the Special Commission of the Flag of Peace, which will be as follows:

Information for sending the money will be provided by the Special Commission.
