It has been a busy biennium for the Pan American Round Table of Edinburg. During this period, our table experienced both a loss and a growth in membership. Members attended local, regional, state and alliance events, heard many great presentations and shared fellowship and camaraderie with each other as well as with other Pan American Round Table sisters.

Our table met a total of 16 times during the biennium. It undertook the study of eight Pan American countries: Argentina, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, and Costa Rica. In addition, our table heard presentations on "The Work of the South Texas Literacy Council in the Rio Grande Valley," "Why We Should Celebrate *el 16 de septiembre*." and heard an inspiring presentation given by Associate Judge Socorro Leos regarding the plight of children and families in Hidalgo County. Our table also enjoyed a "Day in the Sun," at Quinta Mazatlan in McAllen where we experienced the wonders of nature.

Six of our members passed away during the biennium including one sister that had been a member of our table for over 50 years and two members that had been Table Directors. We recruited, conducted orientation and inducted seven new members that are already busy in committees, making presentations and enjoying working with their Pan American sisters. Our Ceremonies Committee conducted Memorials, a Recommitment Ceremony, Inductions, and a Founders Day Remembrance ceremony for our table that were executed with precision, respect and formality.

The Pan American Round Table of Edinburg also participated in events held by our sister tables throughout the Valley. We visited and attended events held by the Brownsville I, Brownsville II, Harlingen, McAllen, and Rio Grande City/Roma tables. Our table conducted the Presentation of Flags at the Joint Pan American Observance Day event held in McAllen and contributed to the Alliance Convention in a couple of ways. Some of our members attended the Re-Dedication of the Bridge Marker ceremony in Laredo prior to the Alliance Convention. At the Alliance

Convention in San Antonio, members of our table helped make and distributed the white flower boutonnieres for the Hour of Memory and eight of our members participated in the Presentation of Flags during the Alliance Convention opening ceremonies dressed in full traditional costumes.

Our most important work and greatest achievement as a table lies in supporting outstanding young women. We awarded eight \$1,000 scholarships to outstanding young women who are pursuing degrees as the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley during this biennium. Each young lady was invited to attend our meeting where we learned about their goals and where they were recognized for their achievements.

It has truly been an active two years for the Pan American Round Table of Edinburg and we look forward to the challenges and surprises of the next biennium.
