In September 2017, packets were sent to the Financial Aid Office, Study Abroad Advisors and International Student Advisors of all Texas colleges and universities with the applications for the Florence Terry Griswold Scholarships I and II. The submission deadline cited was January 31, 2018.

Twenty-seven applications for Scholarship I were received back. One did not qualify, as it was incomplete. Therefore, only twenty-six applications were scored. Three applications were received for Scholarship II, but only one was complete.

All complete and qualifying applications were mailed to members of the FTG Board of Trustees and the two committee members in February. Graduate students applying were from Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Granada, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Trinidad & Tobago, Peru, USA and Venezuela.

These scholarships are made available thru the dues from the Texas tables and Honorariums and Memorials. The donations will be acknowledged to both the donor and the person honored.

The committee and the Board of Trustees received copies of all the applications and rated them and selected the best applicants to receive the scholarship.
