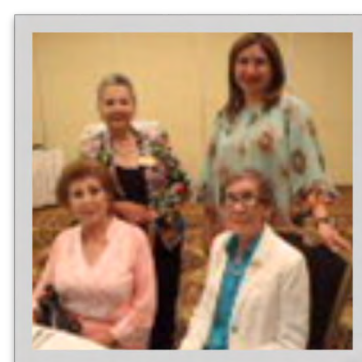

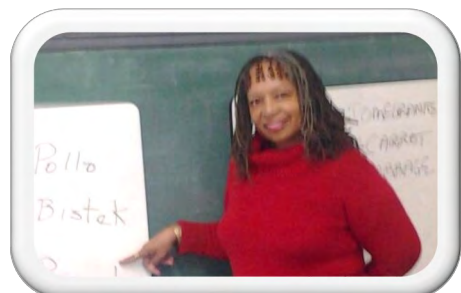

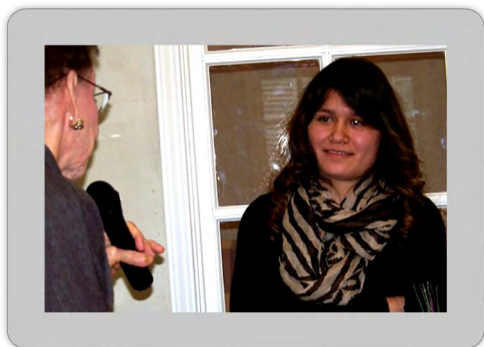

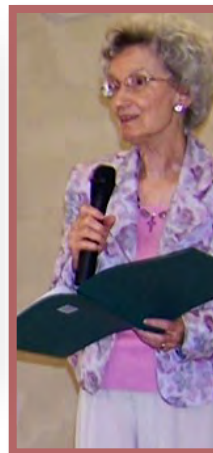

## Upper Valley Tables Host Pan American Day

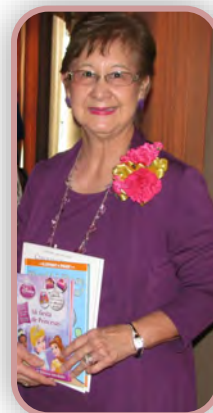

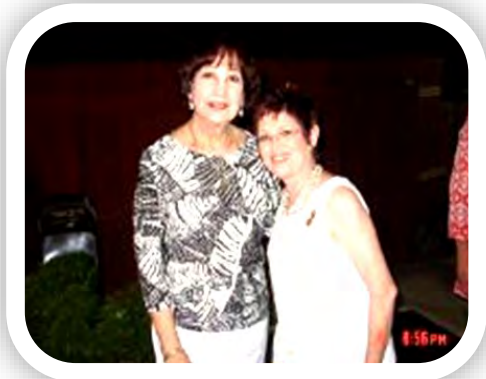

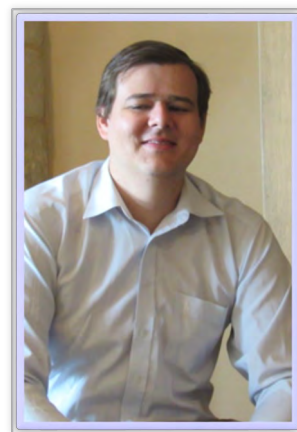
